BSMS minimum Windows or Mac laptop specification Autumn 2020

In the context of university study, the expectation is that as a student you should be able to access the following basic IT requirements:

- 1. Access to the internet at your place of residence. If you are staying in University halls this will be included in your charges.
- 2. We strongly recommend that all incoming BSMS students ensure that they bring a suitable laptop computer with them to enable them to make the most of the learning opportunities at BSMS over the 5 years of the course.

We recommend a minimum Windows or Mac specification of:

- i5 CPU (or equivalent and **not** more than two years old) with:
- Windows 10 or Mac OS 10.14 or later
- 8Gb RAM
- 13" screen
- 256GB Hard Drive (SSD)
- Wi-Fi capable
- a Full HD screen as a minimum (1080p)
- built-in webcam (720p minimum) and speakers
- a DVD drive is not essential

Note:- A lower specification may be used but it may not prove suitable for all needs.
