

## *Cohort & Longitudinal Studies Enhancement Resources* – CLOSER

CLOSER is an interdisciplinary partnership of leading social and biomedical longitudinal population studies, based at UCL Social Research Institute. CLOSER is funded by the Economic and Social Research Council (ESRC) and Medical Research Council (MRC). It aims to maximise the use, value and impact of cohort and longitudinal studies by providing high quality resources and sharing expertise to develop and support international and national projects.

### **CLOSER Discovery**

One of the freely available resources is [CLOSER Discovery](#) – a tool that enables researchers to search, browse and explore questionnaires and data from the UK's leading longitudinal population studies. Users of the CLOSER Discovery feature can search through rich metadata and filter by study, topic and life stage to find the relevant data for their research. By using metadata, CLOSER Discovery allows researchers to explore and find out what's available in UK longitudinal datasets, as well as additional contextual information about the data. Researchers can explore the study's metadata to find detailed information about the questions and variables from the study of interest, covering a range of topics such as mental and physical health, housing and local environment, family, education, employment and income, pregnancy and more.

Discovery is a useful navigation tool guiding researchers through the often messy and confusing data access arrangements in place and handled by the individual datasets. It does not hold any study data and is not designed to manage complex data access processes. Discovery signposts to where access requests for each study dataset can be made, as well as directing to further information about data access arrangements, making it a valuable resource.

Some of the cohort and longitudinal studies included in the CLOSER Discovery tool are:

- 1970 British Cohort Study
- Born in Bradford – BiB
- Avon Longitudinal Study of Parents and Children – ALSPAC
- English Longitudinal Study of Ageing – ELSA
- Millenium Cohort Study

**CLOSER Cross-study data guides**

The cross-study data guides are another resource available on CLOSER. These guides encourage a more standardised, harmonised measurement of different research themes both within and across studies. The cross-study guides are easily searchable, helping researchers explore and compare available measures used to assess different themes (for example cognition, physical activity, diet) used in a number of UK longitudinal studies.
