# BS HRP Governance Structure

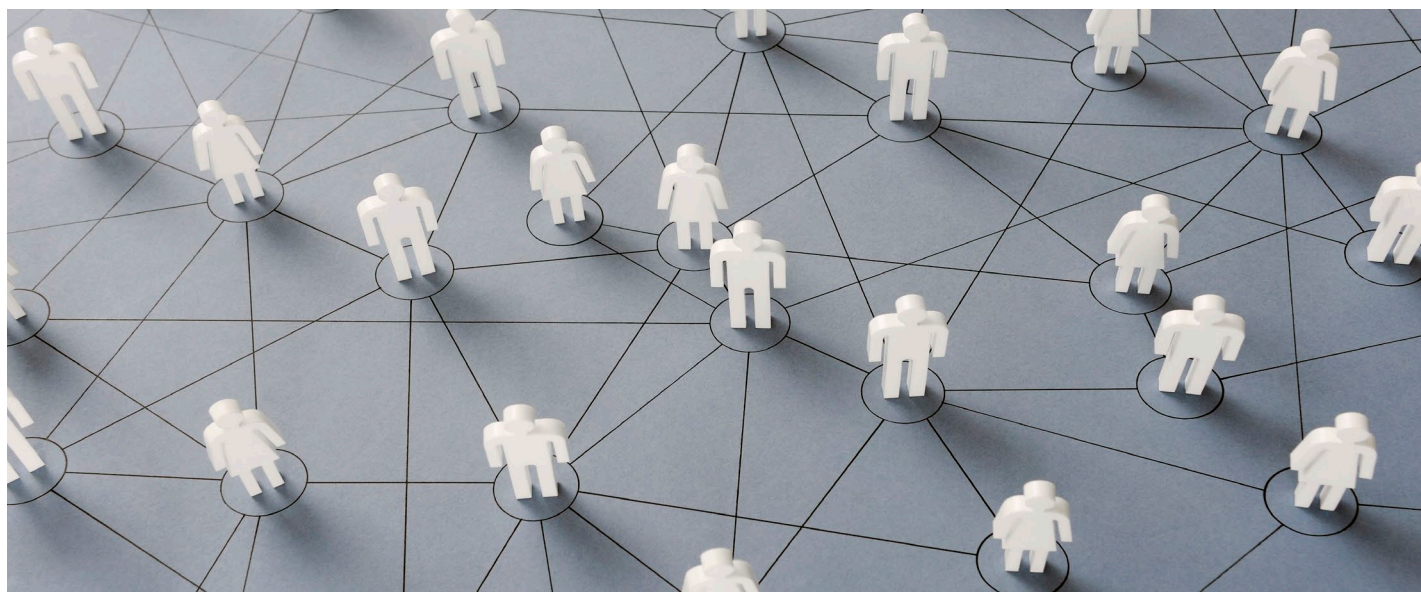
## Cross partner structure agreed
