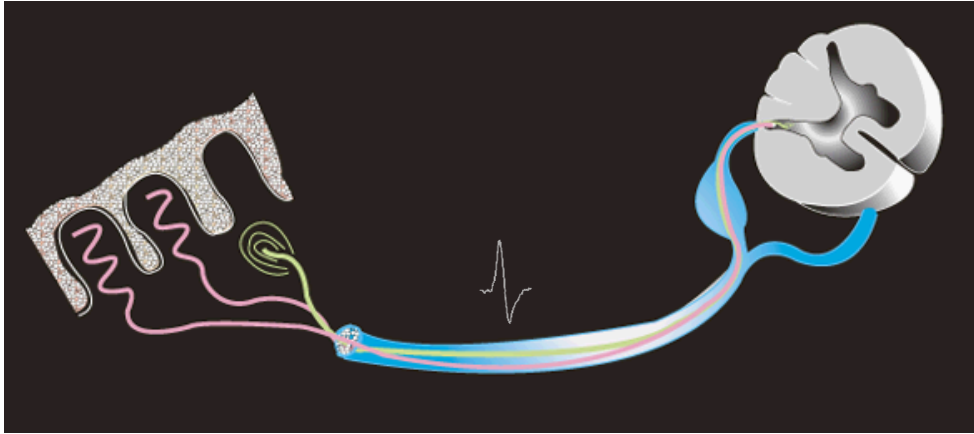


Do you want to take part in pain research?



We are looking for healthy volunteers aged 18-60 to undertake research exploring how our nerves detect pain, touch and temperature sensations from the skin.

The research will involve using a fine needle to record the impulses from a nerve in either the arm or leg. This is safe and well-tolerated. This research has been approved by the Science, Engineering and Medicine: Brighton and Sussex Medical School (BSMS) Faculty Research Ethics Committee (F-REC) (reference: ERA/BSMS1642/2).

The appointment will take up to 3 hours and will be held on the University of Sussex campus.

You will be paid £15 per hour for your time as well as travel expenses.
